



OVERVIEW



Many All Nations' teams are reaching people groups who do not have the Bible – oral, solar, video, an online APP or print – in their heart languages. This includes more than 2,000 churches in Malawi where new believers are without access to the Bible. Many of these people groups are oral cultures. The Tibetan people, for example, have continually resisted written translations of the Bible and other formats that are culturally inappropriate. On the other hand, many villagers in Zambia are without electricity and need simple written translations. The Yawo throughout Southeast Africa and the nomadic East Pokot of Northwestern Kenya remain poor and uneducated. Other groups are surrounded by war and suffer much persecution for their faith, such as the Menings and Nubians.

All Nations' teams are working creatively to get God's Word to them. The S family* is producing a video series of the Bible from creation to eternity in various Tibetan languages. Kenyan fieldworker Eric* and his family have planted a successful business near the East Pokot where they are discipling new believers. One female leader who lives among the Nubians in Uganda is being discipled and in turn is discipling other women and men in their homes. Ugandan fieldworker Emma* is mentoring three Menings recently trained as church planters to ignite movements to Christ among their people. In Malawi, an explosive church planting movement began with signs and wonders after fieldworkers Oliver and Rhoda prayed for those with diseases and demons.

PRAYER POINTS

For the people groups, please pray for...

- the Gospel to be shared in a way they can hear and receive it
- the provision of Bibles oral, solar, video, an online APP or print – in their heart languages and in formats appropriate for their specific needs
- God's Word to be received with excitement by believers and with interest from unbelievers
- disciples who will lead simple churches appropriate for their settings
- those being discipled to have a heart to go to the unreached
