OVERVIEW



The Tonga people live in the Southern Province of Zambia, a country at the crossroads of Central, Southern and East Africa and named after Africa's fourth largest river: the Zambezi. Originally, the Tonga lived without a centralized political structure, but in 1888 chiefs were assigned when they came under British rule. Prior to the colonization, the first Christian missionaries had arrived and established schools. When Zambia gained independence in 1964, there was a noticeable growth in Christianity. Though Zambia is considered a Christian country today, most Tonga still trust in their traditional belief systems and have little understanding about Jesus and what He has done for them.

All Nations' missionary family, the Muungas, has been working with the Tonga in the Livingston and Kazungula districts for over five years. They have focused on discipleship programs, teaching, training and mobilizing, as well as social service efforts to empower, educate and help with community needs. Their hope is to soon reach the Tonga in the Western Province in the Mulobezi district. Their vision is to see transformed communities worshiping Jesus.
