OVERVIEW



The Dolpa people live in extremely remote, high elevation locations in Nepal. They endure severe weather conditions while living in stone houses, many without electricity. The nearest road to the edge of this people group is a two-week trek into the Himalayas. In the region of Upper Dolpa, there are no known believers. There are also few Christian resources available in their language.

All Nations' missionary family, the Roets, have been working in Nepal since 2015. Recently, God moved upon their hearts to reach the unreached. They are currently working with Mr. P* in Nepal to send out scouts to the Upper Dolpa area. In Nepal as a whole, Mr. P has planted +46 churches. The Roets also have been to several unreached people groups to reach out with the Gospel, but they have not yet been to the Dolpa. While it is unknown if there are any believers among the Dolpa people group, they know of none inside the Upper Dolpa region. The closest church is a ten-

day walk south in Dorpatan. The Roets' hope is to start a church plant among the Upper Dolpa.

Yes, All Nations, I want to support this and all the programs and other ways All Nations reaches the neglected for Jesus.

- them to become more known so the prayers of outsiders will increase
- a way to minister and improve their livelihoods in a tangible way
- God to open doors and send workers to them
- Nepali believers to be raised up to take Gospel recordings to them
- their deliverance from all fears hindering them from embracing God's blessings
- them to understand God's Word when they hear it
- a disciple making movement to start among them

- their finances, that all their needs will be met
- access and provision to reach the Upper Dolpa people
- for physically fit, spiritually strong, resilient workers to join them
- the Lord's protection and favor upon them
- divine wisdom and strategy for their upcoming scouting trip

- · local church planters to join them
- God's direction on how to start a church among the Upper Dolpa
