OVERVIEW



Since the 1970s, the USA's resettlement program has been serving the most vulnerable cases of refugees. Refugees are those outside their country of nationality who are unable or unwilling to return because of the high probability of persecution. The southwestern part of Missouri has received S'gaw Karen and Pwo Karen refugees from Myanmar, a predominately Buddhist country. While the S'gaw Karen people group has been reached with the Gospel, many are still nominal Christians. The Pwo Karen people group, however, remains predominately Buddhist, including all those in Missouri's refugee community.

All Nations' missionary family, the Martins, has been working with the refugees in Missouri since October 2022. They are currently searching for persons of peace, discipling those who are interested, and facilitating Bible study groups. Their hope is to see a truly transformed community -- one that follows and obeys Jesus and worships together with their own people and in their own language. Their desire is to plant a reproducible church with the vision of reaching the nations.
