KANGEAN ISLANDS OF CENTRAL INDONESIA



- **Called:** Kangean people
- **Total population:** 124,000
- **Languages:** Kangean (Others: Bajo & Bugis, Mandar & Madurese)
- **Main Religions:** Islam



Indonesia's cluster of Kangean Islands is located in the Java Sea, just east of Madura and north of Bali. Kangean families there are seeing some changes in economic and educational deficiencies with the establishment of high schools and higher education centers since the Covid-19 lockdowns. Although traditionally fearful and suspicious of foreigners, they are increasingly opening up to outsiders. Their schools are being aggressively influenced by outsiders with Islamic thinking. The Kangeans remain one of the most unreached people groups in Central Indonesia. Their practice of Islam is mixed with animistic beliefs and rituals to appease spirits.

All Nations' fieldworkers, the Frank* family, have lived in Bali for nearly nine years. In addition to discipling local believers, they have been praying specifically for the Kangeans. In June 2019, the Franks took their first scouting trip to the Kangean Islands. Their team prayed onsite, gathered logistical information, and began building relationships. They have made some important contacts since 2019 but have yet to see significant inroads of the Kingdom happen among them. The Franks' vision is to capture God's heart for the Kangean people and see His Kingdom come to this neglected people group.
