A LEGACY REACHING THE NEGLECTED

Floyd Lee McClung, Jr., was born in Long Beach, California, on August 3, 1945, to Enetha and Floyd Sr., a lifelong Church of God pastor. Floyd, his brother Alan and sister Judy grew up moving every few years, with stops in Arizona, Kansas and Illinois before returning to Ontario, California, where Floyd attended high school and enjoyed being the captain of the basketball team.

Floyd's college years were first spent at Taylor University in Indiana, then Southern California College (now Vanguard University), where he graduated in 1967 with a Bachelor of Arts in New Testament Studies. During school breaks, Floyd joined Youth With A Mission (YWAM) on missions trips and in 1965 met his future wife Sally on an outreach in Las Vegas, Nevada. They married two years later.

The McClungs' married life was one full of missions experiences. In 1971, they led missional communities in India and Afghanistan with outreaches to hippies and drug addicts and later served among prostitutes in Amsterdam's Red Light District. Floyd served a total of 35 years with YWAM, with nearly eight of those as YWAM's International Executive Director.

From 1991 to 2005, the McClungs pioneered many leadership training programs in the United States. Among these was the founding of All Nations, an international leadership training and church-planting network. Their vision for All Nations was "to see Jesus worshiped by all peoples of the earth, reaching the least, the last and the lost." Today, All Nations International oversees five hubs which train, send and care for fieldworkers. All Nations has more than 400 full- and

part-time workers in more than 40 countries worldwide. The organization has key global training and sending hubs – All Nations Kansas City, All Nations Cape Town, All Nations Hamburg, All Nations Kampala, and All Nations Tainan (launching in 2021).

In his more than 50 years in full-time ministry, Floyd worked on every continent except Antarctica, and authored 18 books, including his international bestseller "The Father Heart of God." He spoke and lectured on more than 100 college and university campuses, traveled to more than 190 countries, made dozens of TV appearances, and saw his life and work featured in countless media, including: Time magazine, The New York Times, and CBS News.

Floyd McClung was preceded in death by his parents, but survived by Sally, his wife of 54 years; daughter Misha Thompson; son Matthew McClung; grandchildren Kezia and Luke Thompson; brother Alan and wife Patricia McClung, their daughter and two grandchildren; sister Judy and husband Jim Orred, their two daughters and two grandchildren.

The very day Floyd became ill in 2016, he spoke to a group of All Nations students. In what turned out to be a prophetic word, he asked them, "If I can't continue, will you finish the race?" His prayer would be that thousands will heed the call to go to the nations.

"Thousands of people from all over the world can attest to the profound impact Floyd had on their lives. While he has gone to be with the Lord, his voice is not silent. His books and recorded teachings will continue to inspire and challenge. His legacy continues."
