Guatemala has the fourth highest rate of chronic malnutrition in the world, leaving almost 50 percent of children under five stunted. With the strict shutdown of the Covid-19 pandemic, hunger and desperation have reached greater scales, causing state hospitals to collapse due to rapidly increasing cases and the pre-existing fragility of their national health system.

Currently, All Nation's long-term missionary family, the Waltons, have converted their ministry facilities into medical clinics and are supplying food to over a thousand people/family groups, particularly widows, single mothers, special needs and the elderly, in nearly 36 surrounding villages in Canilla.

PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for continued favor, protection and wisdom for the Waltons and their staff, as they work with municipal leadership, government health facilities, and the local population in Quiche.
- for the provision of the following urgent needs: appropriate sanitary protective equipment, oximeters, thermometers, medicines, 30 beds, sheets and blankets, cleaning equipment and a washing machine.
- for the proper functioning of the Walton's ambulance bus and safety as they transport patients to regional medical clinics and hospitals.
- for continued food supply and distribution to the surrounding rural areas in Canilla.
- for the healing and protection of adult seniors at House of Refuge.
- for provision and safe housing of homeless single mothers with young children at Good Samaritan House.
- for corruption to cease among law enforcement, and for justice and protection for innocent civilians.
